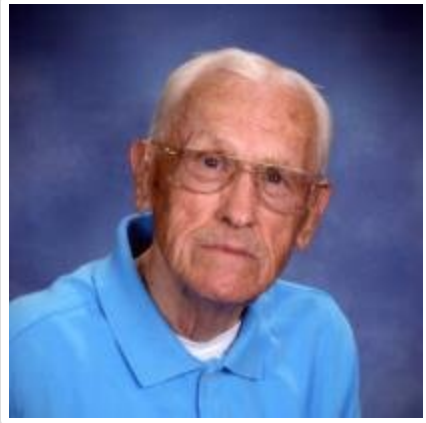




## Alvin Arndt Jacobsen
