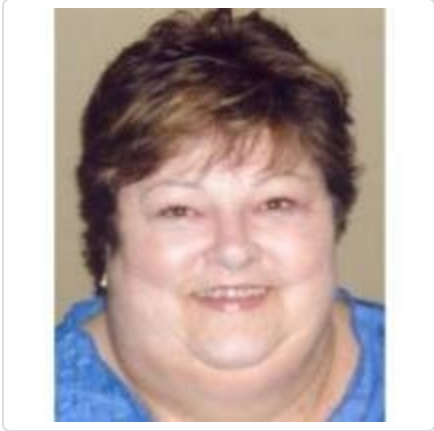




Carlene Brady

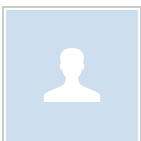

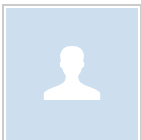
