Rev. Dale Lee Hunter, age 79 of Evensville, passed away on Saturday, September 28, 2024, at his home. He was born on July 21, 1945, in Thirtyfour Corner, Missouri, the son of the late Raymond and Sylvia (Biven) Hunter. He was also preceded in death by his brother, Gary Hunter.

Dale lived in Kelseyville, California before moving to Evensville in 2021. 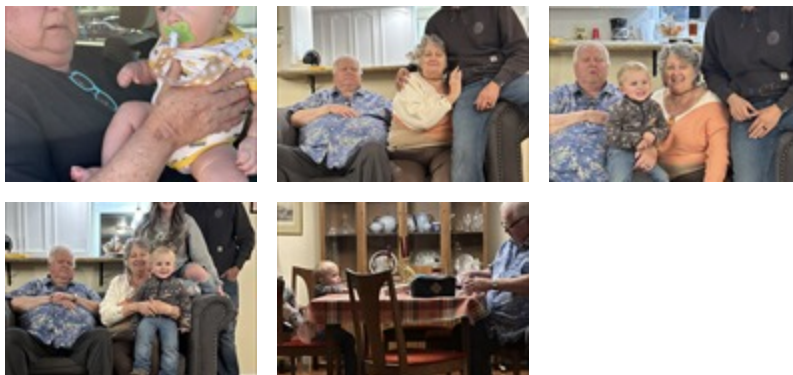
