Doyle Mack Argo, age 89, of Dayton, passed away peacefully with his family at his side in Knoxville, TN on Tuesday, September 1, 2020. 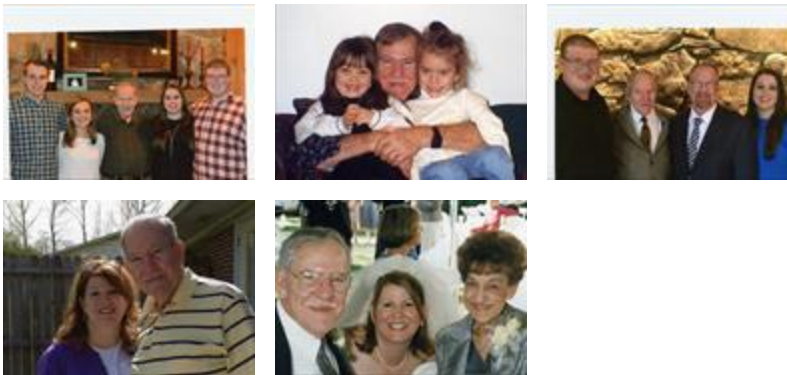
