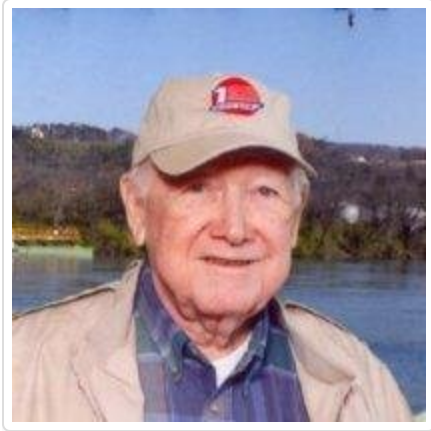




Mr. Edwin Rucker Payne
