Ethel C. Hatcher, age 88 of the Wolf Creek area of Spring City, passed away at her home early Thursday, March 24, 2022. 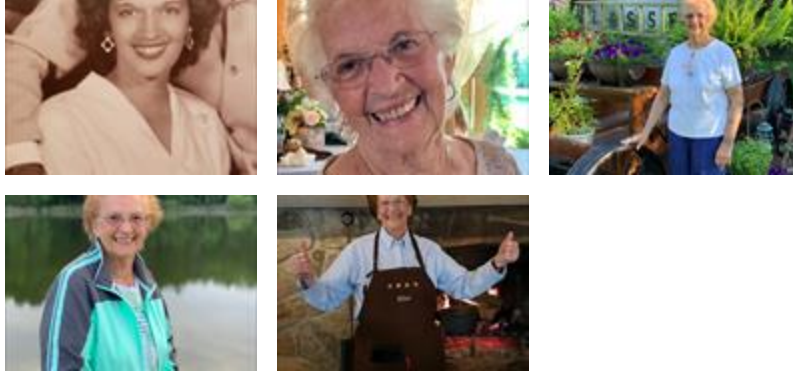
