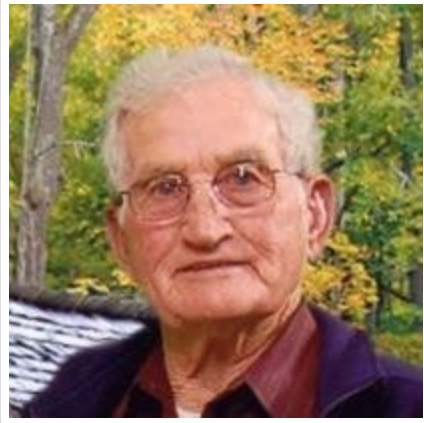




Floyd Broyles Housley

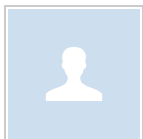
