Frank Fred Alba, age 83 of Dayton died Sunday morning, August 29, 2010 at Parkridge Hospital in Chattanooga. Frank was born in NYC, NY on March 7, 1927 the son of the late Francis Michael Alba and Harriet (Haberle) Alba. He was also preceded in death by his brother Randolph Alba and his granddaughter Jeanette Anne Smith.

Frank served his country with the US Navy in the south pacific during WWII and was on board the USS Missouri when the Japanese surrendered to the United States. Frank retired as an assistant foreman for the NYC sanitation department and lived on Staten Island, NY until moving to Dayton in 2007.

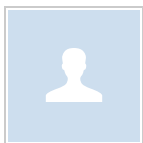
