Gerald "Jerry" White, age 90 of Springboro, OH, and formerly of Dayton, passed away on Monday, May 16, 2022, at the Enclave of Springboro. He was born on June 26, 1931, in Herald, VA, the son of the late Carl and Flossie (Carico) White.
