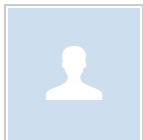
After having just gone through the same thing I know that this is a difficult time for all of you. At least you know your mom is home with the Lord and that you will see her and be with her again some day.

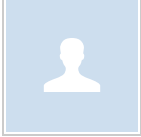

“ Dear Mary, Frances and Carolyn...

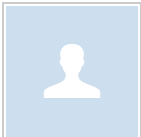
We hurt with you in the loss of your dear mother. We are never ready for that time to come.
