John Emmett Dulaney, Jr. age 61 of Johnson City, TN died April 25, 2007 in the James H. Quillen VA Hospital. He was born in Rhea County July 20, 1945 and lived in Dayton until moving to Johnson City 17 years ago.

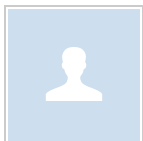

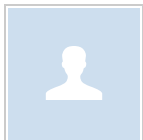

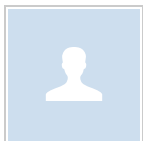
