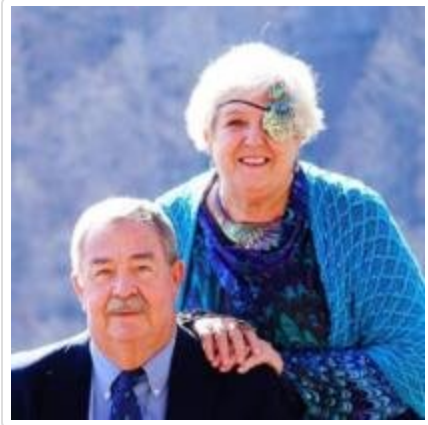




Karen F. Clark
