A graveside funeral service for Kathleen will be held on Sunday at 2:00pm at Smyrna Cemetery in Evensville followed by a white dove release.

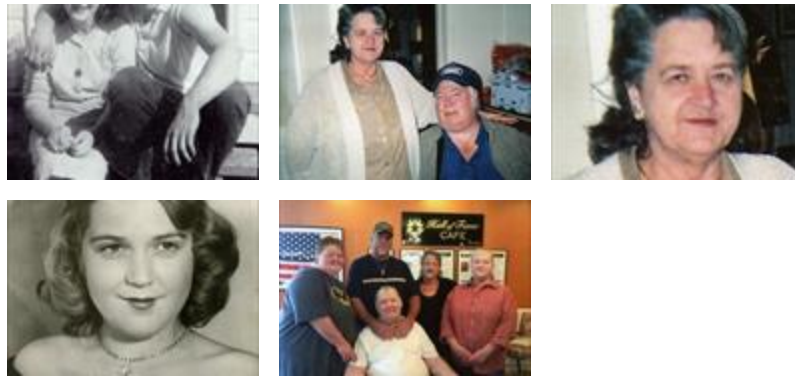
