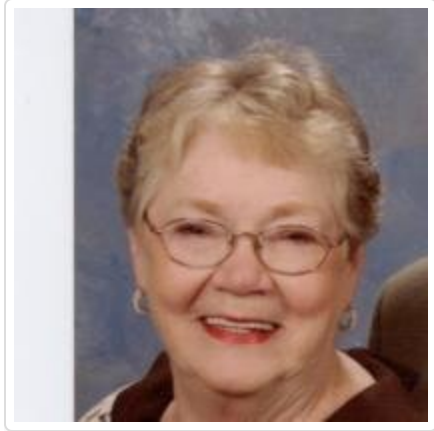




Margie Dean Morgan
