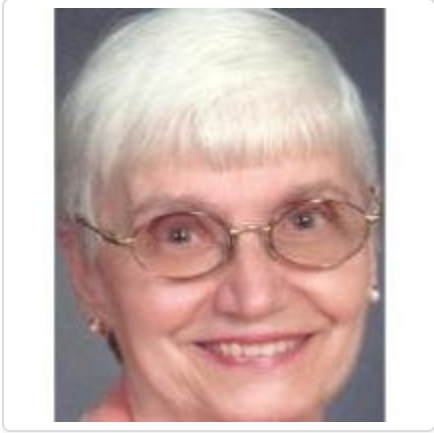




Mary Celia Bradshaw

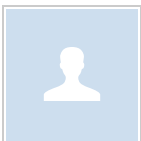

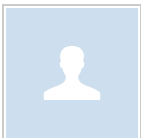

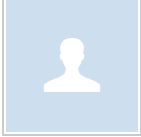
