Mildred Ellen Ross, age 91 of Hixson went to be with her Lord Thursday, June 18, 2009 in Chattanooga, TN. Mildred was born February 10, 1918 in Indian Falls, NY, the daughter of the late Harold A. and Adella Fern (Lester) Meiser. She was also preceded in death by her husband, Rev. Vincent R. Ross.
