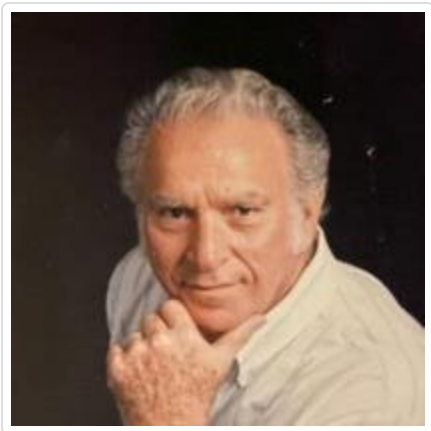




Morris Ray Chadwick
