Richard Paul Tallent, Sr., age 77 of Daisy and formerly of Graysville died early Saturday morning May 1, 2010 at Hospice of Chattanooga. Paul was born in Dayton on November 27, 1932 the son of the late Gaines and Betty (Holland) Tallent. He was also preceded in death by his son, Chris Tallent and two brothers, Thomas Tallent and James Pierce.

Paul served his country with the US Army during the Korean War and was a member of the American Legion and VFW. 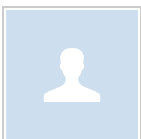
