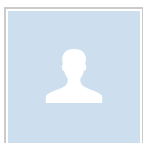
The family is being served by the Vanderwall Funeral Home where they will receive friends Monday morning before the service.

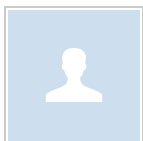
