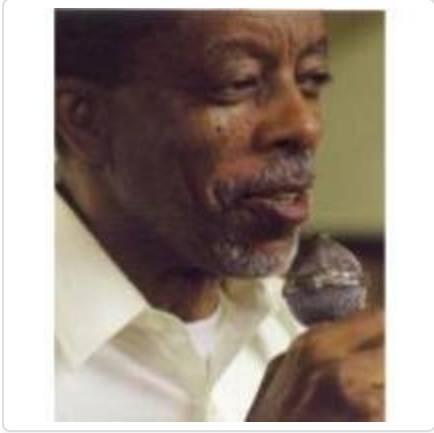




Steve Minter
