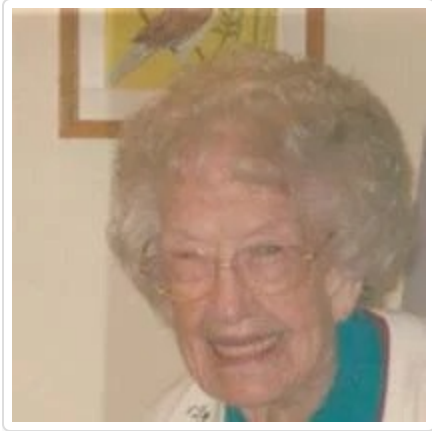




Mrs. Virginia Mary Norris
