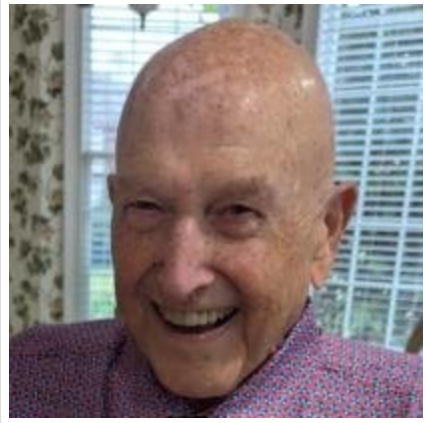




William Carter Lusk Jr
